- Application form.  
*Fill out the form on the reverse side completely. Any applications that are incomplete will not be considered.*
- Current color photograph.  
*Preferably your senior photo.*
- Current high school transcripts.  
*Please attach most recent copy, including grade point average.*
- SAT or ACT scores (SAT are preferable, please).  
*Photocopy is acceptable.*
- Two recommendations.  
*Two letters of recommendation from individuals that can attest to your spiritual growth (e.g. pastor, teacher, counselor, principal, coach, small group leader, mentor, or employer).*
- A single sheet of paper listing your extracurricular activities, honors, memberships, leadership positions, and major accomplishments in the last two years. Please include any involvement you have had at MCS since your 8<sup>th</sup> grade graduation.  
*Must be typed.*
- A minimum 250-word essay (maximum 500 words) on “How my MCS education has impacted my success in school and life.”  
  
*Must be typed. Applicants are encouraged to include how MCS's mission of "building a firm foundation through Christ-centered education" impacted their high school experience.*
